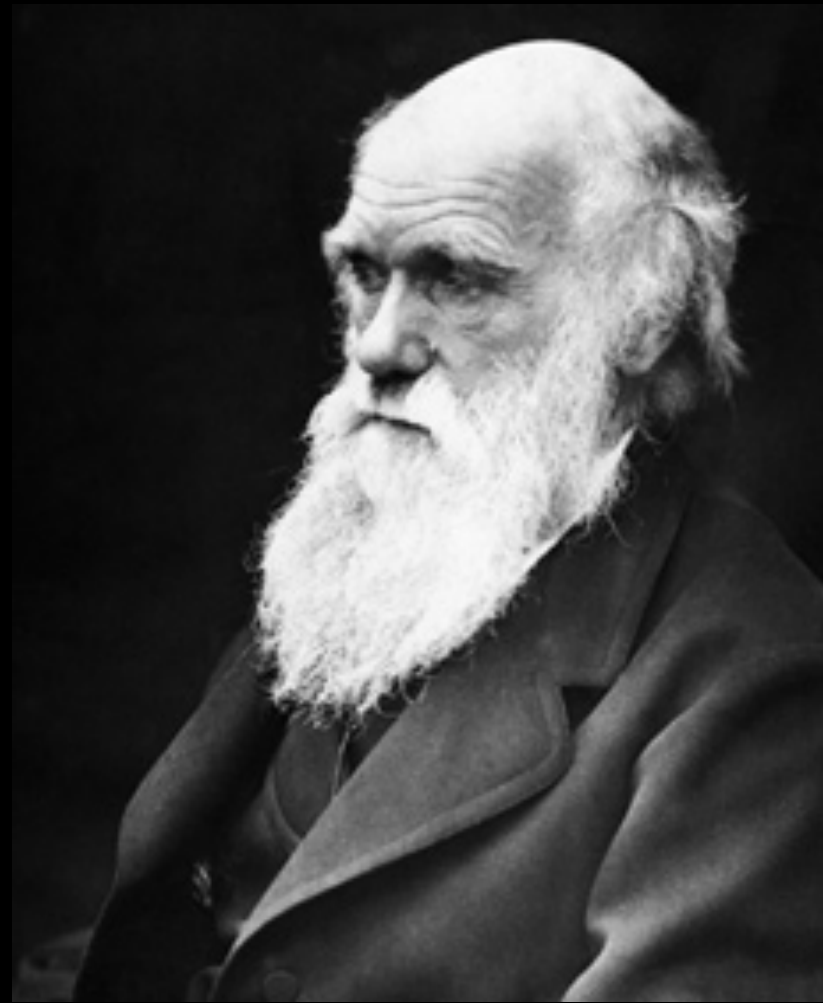

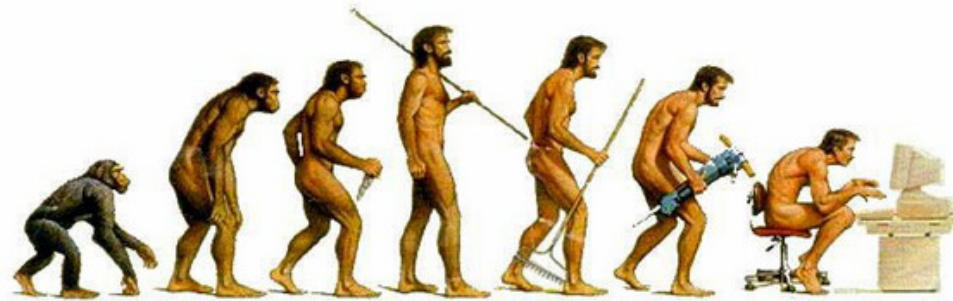

THE FOLLOWING LETTER SENT TO THE ATTACHED LIST (✓)

Subspecialization in Radiology has been with us for many years. It is in the more recent past, however, that subspecialty practice in bone radiology has become more prevalent. With one-third of radiology practice being comprised of skeletal and joint exams, this is an appropriate response to provide adequate education and consultation in the basic understanding of these problems.

Some of us who practice bone radiology in the southeast now feel that formation of a Southeastern Society of Skeletal Radiology would be appropriate. The purpose of such a society would be to provide for information exchange, continuing education and improved communication between those of us who practice skeletal radiology in the southeast.

For the purpose of the establishment of the society, we would appreciate hearing from anyone in your department whose primary interest is skeletal radiology. Based upon this response, we will formulate plans for a first meeting and the appropriate legal manipulations.

The following letter was sent to the attached list:

The response to our first letter regarding the formation of a Southeastern Skeletal Society has been tremendous. Enclosed with this letter is a roster of the names received from various departmental chairmen or skeletal radiologists in the southeast. We are now investigating the possibility of an organizational meeting in the spring or early summer at Hilton Head Island, South Carolina.

To review briefly our initial inquiry; many of us in the southeast who practice bone and joint radiology feel that it would be useful to have a regional society for the exchange of information and to allow for the establishment of better communication in our areas of interest. It is also our feeling that this might take the form of interesting case presentations and discussion or short presentations of any material thought useful to the group. This would, in some ways, follow the format of the International Skeletal Society presentations as they are given in

To promote personal relationships, we further feel that these festivities should occur in a place conducive not only to intellectual interest, but also to relaxation and enjoyment of the outdoors. We would anticipate a two or possibly three day meeting over a weekend with several hours in meeting each day and the remainder of time free for family recreation.

If you know of anyone primarily interested in bone radiology whose name does not appear on the enclosed list, then please forward that information to us. Also, should you have any suggestions about the formation of the society or its objectives, we would also appreciate that input.

Plans for an organizational meeting will be formulated as soon as details can be worked out, and will be forthcoming in the near future.
